

Common Regulation

The Armailli Trail Challenge (ATC)

1. The ATC consists of four races in the Swiss Pre-Alps in Trail Ultra Medium (M) format each worth between 2 and 3 ITRA points:
 - a. the Trail des Paccots, 42km 2'700m D +/- (2 pts ITRA), Sunday June 2nd, 2019
 - b. the Gruyère Trail Charmey, 54km 3'800m D +/- (3 pts ITRA), Saturday July 20th, 2019
 - c. the Barlatay SuperTrail, 46km 2'700m D +/- (2 pts ITRA), Saturday August 17th, 2019
 - d. the Pre-Alps Trail of the Mouret, 50km 2'800m D +/- (3 pts ITRA), Sunday September 22nd, 2019
 2. The runner must take part and finish at least three of the four races mentioned above (relay excluded) to participate in the ATC. Duos / patrols may also take part in the individual ranking.
 3. The time achieved for each of his races will be converted into points according to the following formula: $1'000 \times (\text{reference time}^* / \text{runner's time})$
- * The reference time corresponding to the best time of the edition and not to the record on the distance concerned.
4. The average of the points obtained on the three best results of each runner during the same season will count for the classification of this challenge.
 5. The participants, all age categories combined, having obtained the best 5 men's and women's averages during this challenge will be rewarded.
 6. The ATC Awards will be held at the end of the season.
 7. All ATC participants will receive a souvenir prize.
 8. The opening of ATC registrations will take place at the same time as the standard registrations, ie February 1, 2019.
